The two-act play is a story of resistance and persistence, featuring four compelling characters: "**Scoobi**" is an undocumented-law-student-love-child of the Zapatista rebellion of 1994. "**Petra**," her mother and former revolutionary, is also undocumented. "**Roko**" whose undocumented soldier-life was taken in Afghanistan, is haunting his lover Scoobi. "**Dylan**" is Scoobi's "all American" ticket to citizenship. On the heels of Scoobi's marriage-of-inconvenience to Dylan, this odd quartet navigates personal and political borders under the constant threat of deportation.
